

Milk Bottle Bird Feeder

A great way to recycle any plastic bottle into a brilliant bird feeder. This can help attract birds to your garden as well as helping them out over winter time when food is harder to find.

You will need

- · Empty plastic bottle, we used a milk bottle. Washed and dried
- · Sticks or wooden spoon
- · String, twine or ribbon
- Bird seed
- 1. Ask a grown up to help you cut the bottle open.
- 2. Draw where you want the opening to be on the bottle for the birds to get the seed from and where the sticks need to be for the birds to perch on.
- 3.Cut out the shapes on the bottle using a sharp knife or scissors. Tie the string around the handle of the bottle in a loop.
- 4. Fill the bottom of the bottle with seed and hang out for the birds.





Top Tips

If you don't have a garden, you can hang your feeder from a window.

You can paint your feeder to make it look unique.
